Break the Weight Challenge

Jackpot Rules

The BTWC will run alongside every tournament sanctioned by the CIAC for each year.

Species Weights

- The target weight to break for any species will be determined by the CIAC Committee at the beginning of the Calendar year.
- The target weights will be determined by averaging the heaviest fish caught in a tournament in each of the last 3 years plus 10% for Dolphin, 15% for Wahoo and 20% for Yellowfin Tuna.
- The weights will stand until either of these two events occur:
 - A team catches a fish heavier than the target weight for the respective species. Once the catch has been verified, the new target weight will be determined by the CIAC Committee.
 - or
 - No team has caught a fish heavier than the target weight by the end of the calendar year. The weights will then be decreased by 2% and this will be the new target weight of the eligible species for the upcoming calendar year.

Buy-in Prices

- THE CIAC Committee reserves the right to set the buy-in price for each species per tournament. The buy-in price will be determined by:
 - the dominant species of the season
 - the featured species of the tournament being held
- The buy-in price will apply to a "Team", not individual anglers.
- Teams have the opportunity to buy-in to one or all pots offered. Pot buy-ins are only eligible for the specific tournament entered. The next tournament will require a new buy-in.
- Buy-in to pots must be paid at registration. Late buy-ins must be paid by 6:00 PM the night before the first fishing day of the tournament and subject to a late fee of \$100.
- All pot buy-ins are non-refundable.



Pot Payouts

- At the beginning of the 2020 calendar year, the pot for each species will start with an injection sponsored by the CIAC. The CIAC Committee reserves the right to determine the size of the injection.
- The total pot purse for the first tournament of the 2020 calendar year will be the CIAC injection plus all entry fees for the respective species pots. (Example \$3,000 injection + (10 team buy-ins at \$300) = \$6,000.)
- At the end of each tournament if no pots have been won, the CIAC will retain 20% of each pot and the remainder will roll forward to the next tournament. This will be the starting value of each pot for the next tournament. All buy-ins for the respective pots will be added to the starting value to make the total purse for each pot. Example: (Tournament #2 – Starting Value = \$4,800 + (10 team buy-ins at \$300) = \$7,800).
- When a pot has been won, the winning team will receive the total purse of that pot.
- After a pot has been won, the pot will restart with an injection sponsored by the CIAC.

Terms and Conditions

- The CIAC Committee reserves the right to revise and amend the BTWC rules or terms and conditions as it sees fit for continuous improvement.
- Fish must be caught in accordance with rules specified by the tournament being fished.
- If more than one fish is caught heavier than the target weight, the heaviest fish will be awarded the pot.
- In the event of a tie the prize shall be awarded to the first team landing the heaviest fish. The time used in determining such awards will be tournament control radio log time.
