Cayman's 13th Annual Swordfish Tournament

The 2019 Cayman Swordfish Challenge is two days of fishing, 10am - 10pm, on Friday 15 March and Saturday 16 March 2019.

This tournament is a team event with a captain and at least one angler. The entry fee is CI\$500 per team of four including the team captain, plus CI\$100 each for any additional anglers.

Total of CI\$20,000 in cash prizes to be won!

Rules

- 1 Conventional manual rod and electric and hydraulic reels are allowed.
- 2 Hours of fishing will be 10am until 10pm.
- 3 All hook-ups must be reported to the tournament control by radio, phone or satellite phone (Control # provided at registration).
- 4 All fish boated or released must be reported to the tournament control boat by radio or phone.
- 5 All anglers must bring their boated fish or photos of releases to the weigh stations: GCM (Barcadere Dock) and CYB (Carib Sands Dock).
- 6 Releases must be verified by a photo of the fish with the tournament t-shirt. Each additional fish photographed must be preceded by a photo of the angler.
- 7 This is a team boat tournament. The rod or reel may be passed from angler to angler.
- 8 All fish must be a minimum of 48 inches from the fork of the tail to the tip of the lower jaw. No boat will keep more than two fish per day. All others must be released.
- 9 Awards will be given for the best total weight of maximum two fish, heaviest single fish and most releases.
- 10 Baits must be rigged with no more than two single hooks, both of which must be secured to the bait. No double hooks allowed.
- 11 Each boat must have a team captain. The team captain will be responsible for registration and payment of fees. All cash prizes will be paid to the team captain.
- 12 The weigh station opens at 10pm. The weigh master will be available (on call) for any fish hooked before the close of the tournament and arrives at the weigh station before 5pm.
- 13 In the event of a tie, the prize will be awarded to the first fish caught or released.
- 14 Weather rule: Winds above 15 knots will cancel the day of fishing. If Friday and Saturday fishing is cancelled, then Sunday will be fished to make up a day. If weather cancels two days of fishing, then one day will constitute a successful tournament.
- 15 All anglers must have fun!
